Trustee Report: The Trustees decided at their March 22nd meeting not to have the Park Commission bid out the park master plan. Beaver Excavating is doing it for free or at minimal cost.

Linda presented all the members with a copy of the Natures Work grant that the Township was awarded to install an adult baseball field and walking trails. Highlighting the pages that gave the specifics of the application that pertained what was approved.

The GIS is completed, the storm water study is being sent to the county for approval. The Park land has been surveyed.
